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HOW TO APPLY FOR A GRANT

1. Complete the New Mexico Real Estate Education Foundation Grant Application, which can be found at www.nmrealtor.com.
2. The application for assistance must be for a specific educational need and accompanied by proper documentation of the Association or Member Affiliate receiving assistance. (The Foundation does not cover routine business expenses or unrelated expenses.)
3. Grant for any single project shall not exceed an aggregate of \$5,000 during any 12-month period without additional prior approval from The Foundation.
4. Application must include completion date. No funds will be disbursed after three months of completion date and without a project completion form.
